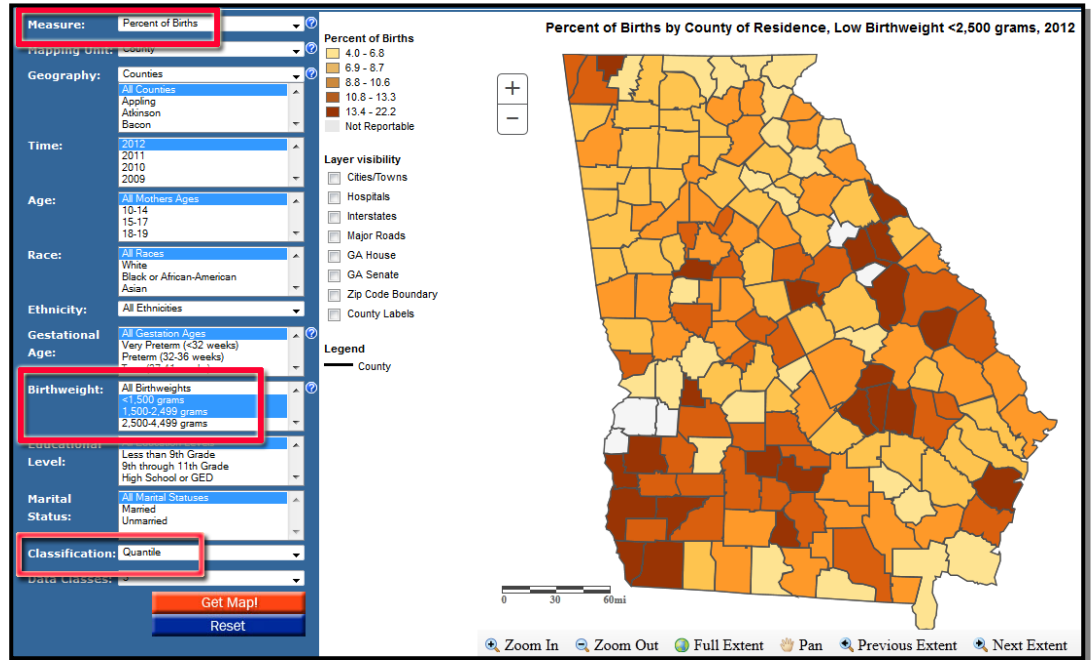




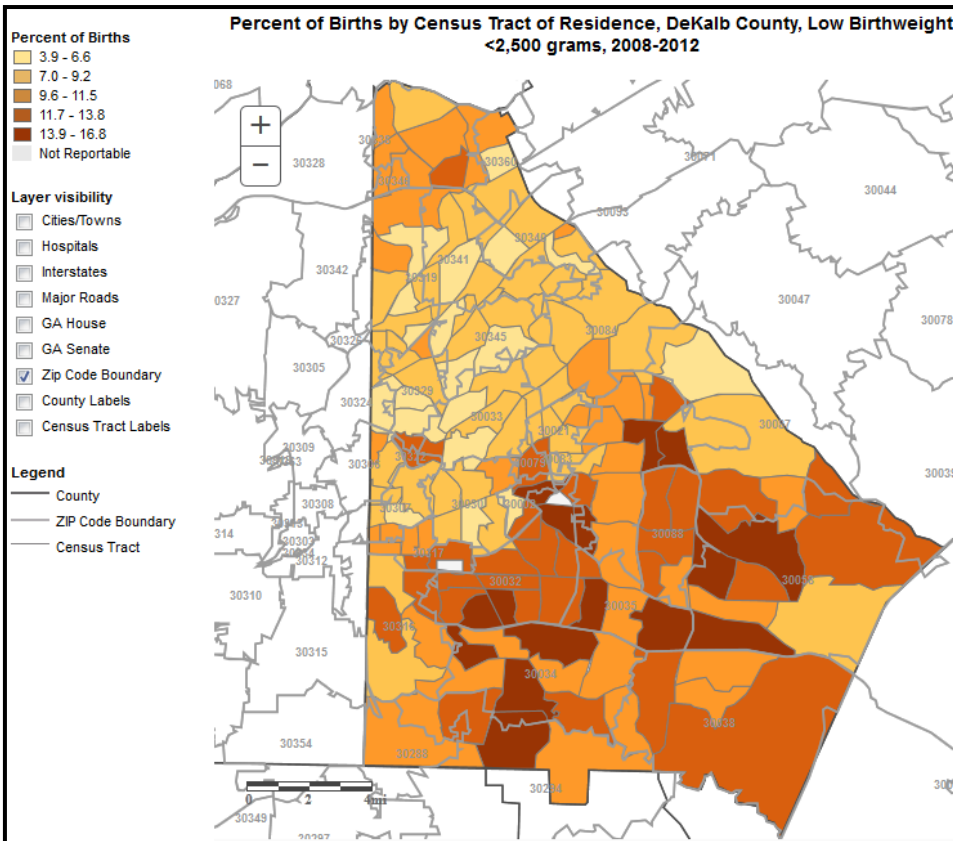
OASIS (<http://oasis.state.ga.us/>) is a suite of tools used to obtain tables, maps, charts, and reports of public health indicators. **The new (August 2014) OASIS MAPPING TOOL is featured here.**

Data include birth, death, fetal death, induced termination, pregnancy, hospitalization, ER visit, STD, and population. Indicators can be selected by age, race, sex, public health district, county, census tract, county commission district, and year.



The figure at right shows *Measure*: 'Percent of Births', *Birthweight*: '<2,500 grams', *Classification*: Quantile:

The figure below shows percent low birthweight by tract in a county: Change *Mapping Unit* to 'Census Tract', *Geography* to 'DeKalb County':



In addition, the zip code overlay is checked to give a spatial reference to the census tracts.
