
Accessing the Georgia Department of Public Health's Data Warehouse

OASIS (http://oasis.state.ga.us/) is a suite of tools used to obtain tables, maps, and charts of a variety of public health indicators. One tool is the Community Health Needs Assessment Dashboard. It is designed to create ready-to-use

data-driven reports.


Example: Muscogee County, Age-Adjusted ER Visit Rate, Males.

A) Initial Page - Shown are the top 10 causes, and a dial indicating "good" or "bad" as compared to the State as a whole, and to all other Georgia counties.



B) Details Page - Clicking an individual dial will send you to a page that includes a trend chart and tract-level map for the cause chosen. In this example, Asthma is chosen.

A **trend chart** shows the trend of ER visits for Asthma, including a test of significance →



A **tract-level map** shows spatial distribution of Asthma within Muscogee County →

- All Dashboard output is exportable to Word format for customization.
- Other features like limiting causes to only those that are significantly high are available.
- Ranking can be done on deaths, discharges, ER visits, or all three combined.
